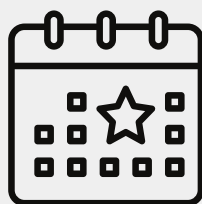

Destiny: Culinary because I like cooking

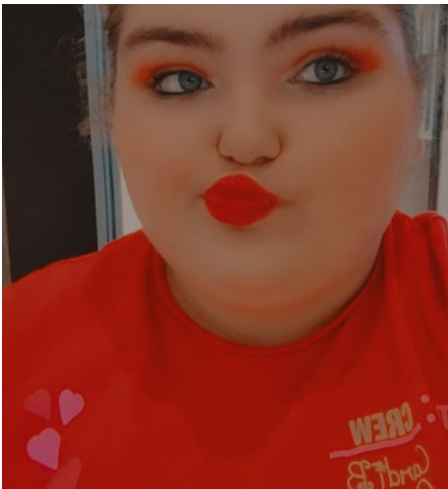
Olivia: Outside of your program is there anything you like about the school?

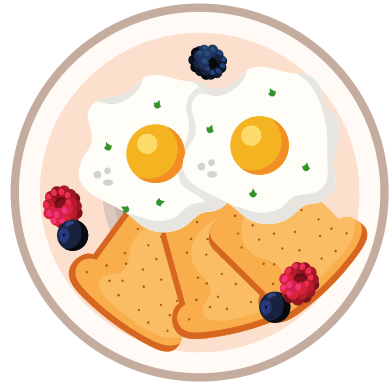

baskets for children



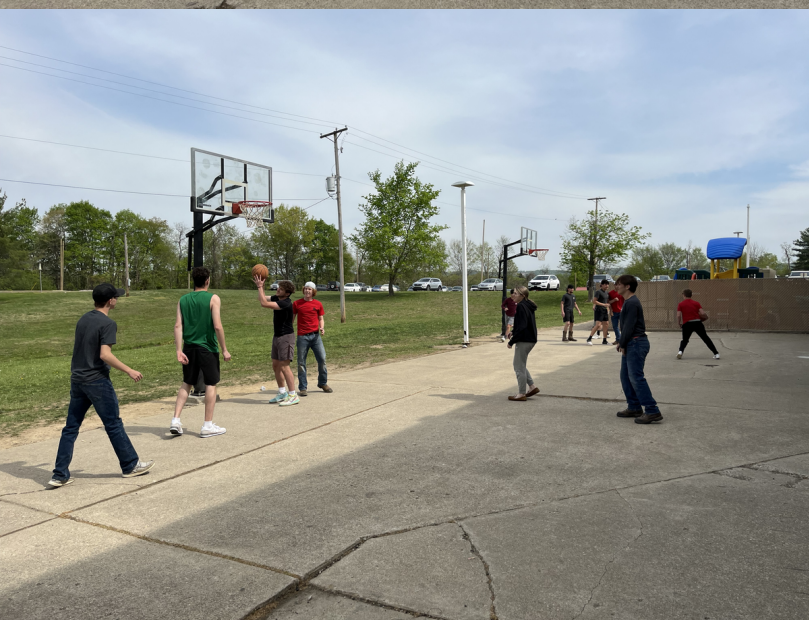
