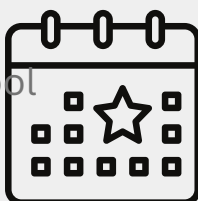

Mr. Cotrill: Mortal Kombat



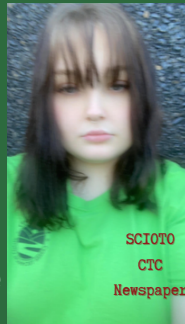
Weekly Questions

Mr. Riggs: Crappie

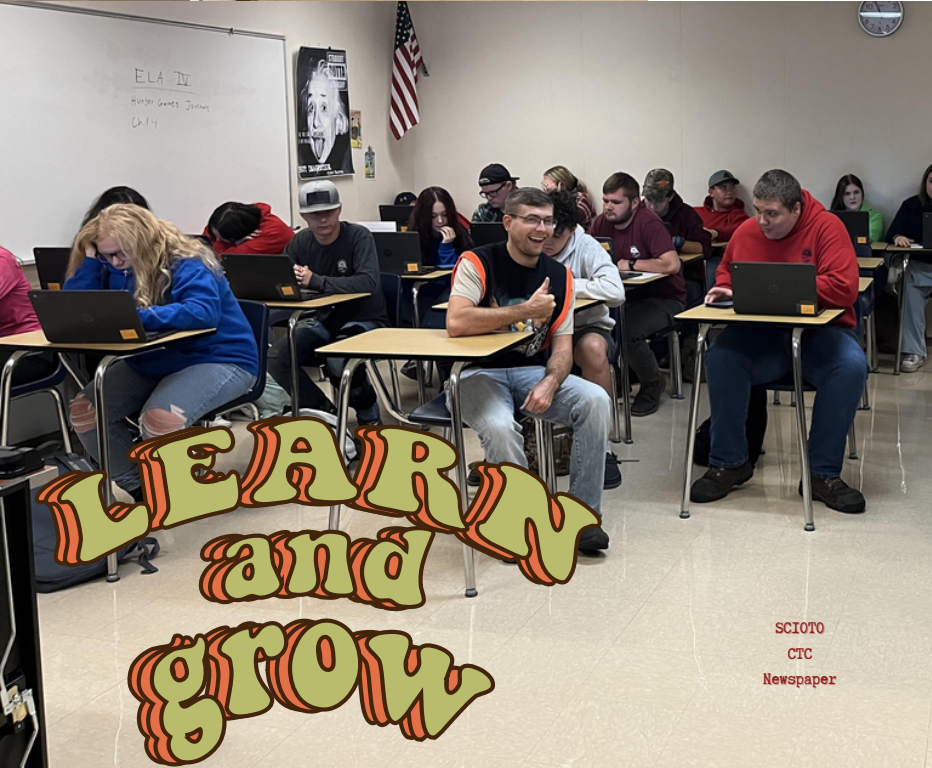
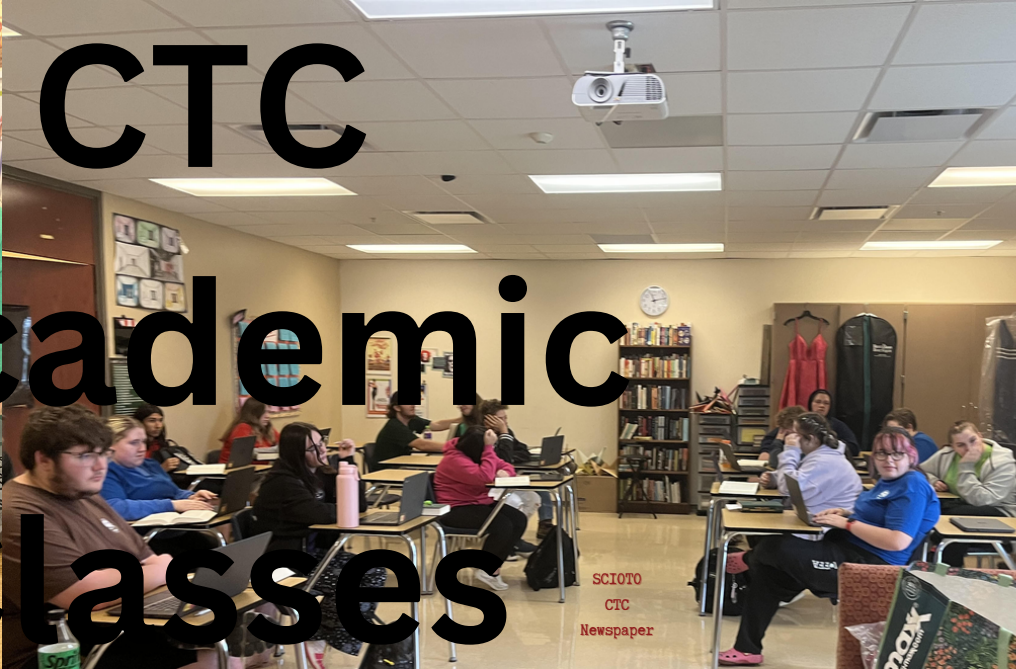
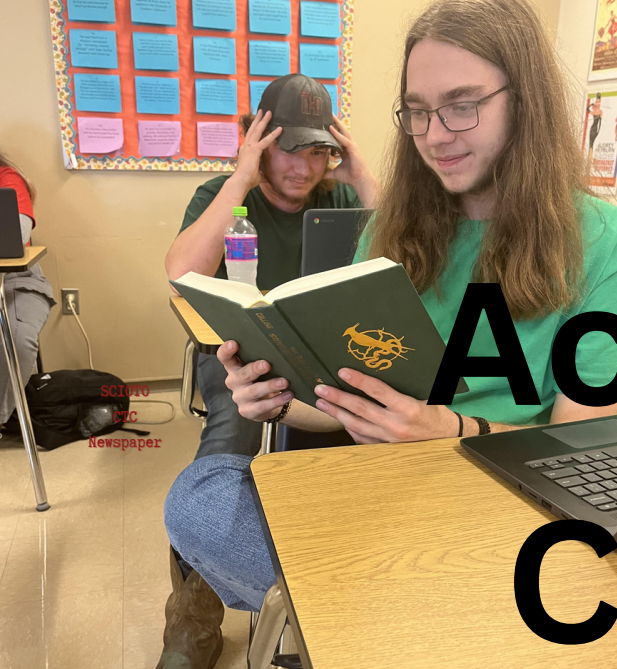
